

Thunderstorm Potential Today

15% chance of thunderstorm activity into the evening across the Bay Area. All thunderstorm chances will end by tonight when the last few cells exit the North Bay.

KEY POINTS

- 15% chance for lightning today
- Some thunderstorms may be dry
- Gusty outflow winds in excess of 35 mph near any high-based shower or thunderstorm
- Increased risk for grass fire ignitions and fire spread

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.


